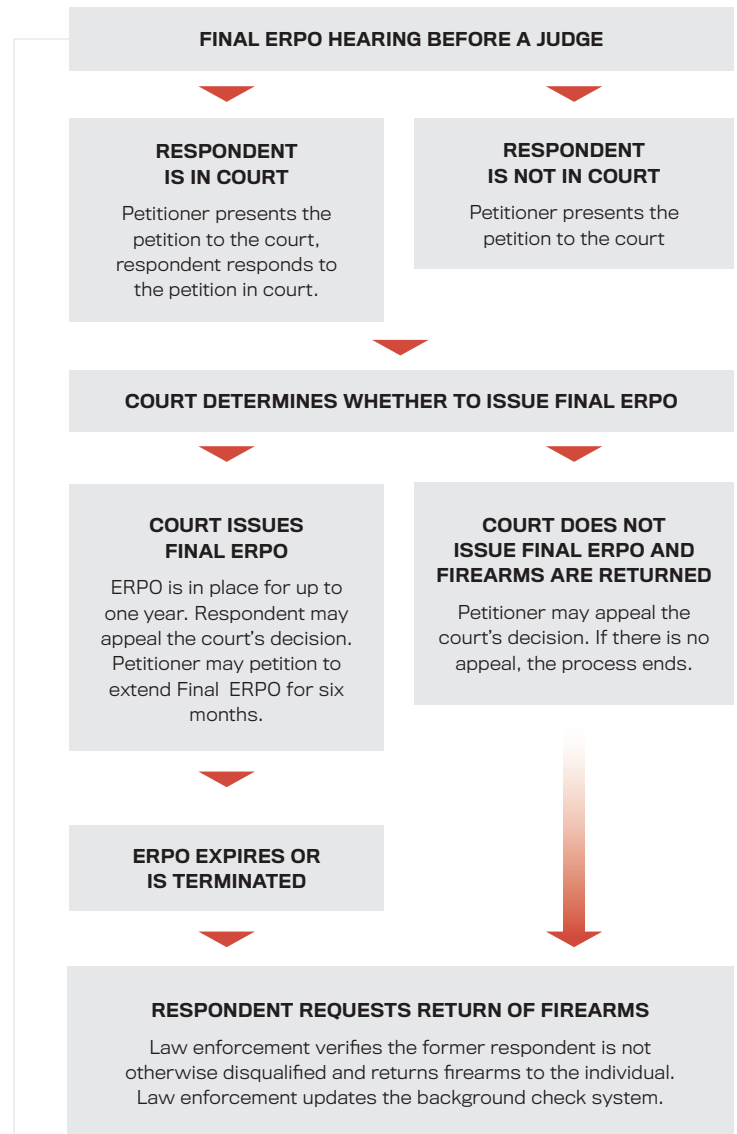
Authorized petitioners in Maryland include:
